But very often we feel anxious about leaving our four legged buddies. We especially feel guilty about leaving our pets in kennels. When you leave for vacation your pet will miss you but it doesn't have to be devastating and you don't have to board them in a kennel. Now you can leave your pet and enjoy your vacation.

Did you know that most kennels or boarding facilities require that your pet be vaccinated with the kennel cough or Brodatella vaccine? It is important to have your dog's vaccinations up to date but kennel cough is not commonly found in household pets so why give a vaccine that is not needed. They also don't tell you that if your dog has a healthy immune system and is exposed to the virus he or she is less likely to attract the virus. Many kennels also only accept dogs that have been spayed or neutered this makes it difficult to board a breeding bitch or stud dog.

I will ask you to bring your pet's favorite bed and a T-shirt or article of clothing with your scent on it to make your dog's stay more comfortable, his or her bowls and favorite food.
